As a result, the rural areas of districts: Rangareddy, Medchal, Yadadri, Bhuvanagiri, Vikarabad, Sangareddy, Medak, and Siddipet will be provided free eye care from this hospital.

The affluent and middle-income residents from the surrounding urban population of Hyderabad will encompass the paying patients.


SEFI'S VISION CENTRE AT MALUR - BENGALURU




